Now is a great time to start cleaning out your safe room/storm shelter and stocking them with necessities such as nonperishable food, water, first aid kits, and extra shoes.

DRTC practices our plan by participating in drills throughout the severe weather season. We have people designated to watch for severe weather in our area. Each building has safe areas identified by the Fire Marshal. Everyone is assigned a specific safe area, and we call roll to make sure everyone is accounted for.

Everyone is alerted of potential for severe weather by our "phase yellow." Our Operations Department and Leadership Team monitor the weather. It is our goal to get everyone home before severe weather impacts. However, if the sirens sound, we all know where our designated safe areas are.

Please make sure all your emergency information is updated so we can reach you in case of an emergency or changes to agency hours and bus route times.
